FLY LOCAL TRAVEL POLICY

We recognize The Eastern Iowa Airport (CID) is an essential strategic economic engine for the Cedar Rapids/Iowa City Corridor and the border regions of Illinois and Wisconsin. Air service is a critical asset that must be integrated into regional economic development discussions such as the Creative Corridor Regional Vision Strategy. Commercial air service cannot be taken for granted as communities are increasingly competitive to retain and attract service. Success will only be achieved through focused regional efforts and the willingness by area business and community leaders and governmental entities to invest in their local air service. This investment is best demonstrated by adopting a travel guideline that encourages and supports the use of air service at CID.

The elements of _____ travel policy are:

When using air travel, the employee will first explore the option of using The Eastern Iowa Airport (CID). If a flight from CID is available and within four (4) hours of travel time each way from flights available at competing airports; and if the cost of the CID flight is within \$300 of the lowest priced tickets at a competing airport, the employee will be required to use CID. Any exception to this policy to use an alternate airport must be authorized in advance by _____.
