## Questions and Answers

1. Can you please provide additional details on chemical for ice management on the terminal ramp area? Will chemical be supplied and applied by the airport; supplied by the airport and applied by the contractor; or supplied and applied by the contractor?

Answer: Our experience with use of multifunction removal unit(s) with plow, broom and blower as outlined in the scope of work, indicates most ice control will be accomplished mechanically. However, the airport will supply and apply all liquid or solid chemicals for ice management, as deemed necessary.

2. What quantity and types of equipment was used in years past? What size plow blades for ramps?

Answer: We use a mix of Oshkosh P-series trucks and HT/XT Multifunction Units, front-end loaders and Oshkosh snow blowers. Anywhere from 18-28' plows/blades. The main reason a RFP for snow removal services was issued is due to a 15 acre increase in apron space being constructed this summer, and a loss of most snow storage space on or near the apron. Consequently, we do not suggest basing this proposal on past practices of the airport.

3. How many melters, and size (melting capacity)?

Answer: We don't have any melters. If you're asking how many and the size for this contract, that would be up for the qualified proposer to determine. The scope is covered in the original RFP.

4. When is the first day equipment can be placed on property?

Answer: Upon receipt of signed contract and certificates of insurance.

5. When is the deadline it is expected?

Answer: October 1, 2021 as outlined in the scope of work.

Can equipment be kept onsite for summer storage?

Answer: Yes, equipment can be kept onsite for the duration of the contract.
